Recommendations for the writing task:

- **1) Adherence to task and content adequacy :**
 - The test takers' production must be adequate to the instructions.If not, the test taker will not be allotted the **C1** mark
- **2) Lexical appropriacy and grammar accuracy:**
 - The vocabulary used by the test taker has to be appropriate to the task .
 - In case of more than two mistakes per sentence, the test taker will get a zero for **C2**.
- **3) Mechanical accuracy (punctuation, capitalization and spelling)**
 - Every sentence must start with a capital letter and end with a full stop.
 - In case of more than two mistakes per sentence, the test taker will get a zero for **C3**.
