We often use the present simple with the following time guides A time guide is a word which helps us to know what time we are talking about (past, present, future) These time guides tell us how often we do things Always

Often, frequently

Usually, generally

Regularly, normally

Sometimes, occasionally

Seldom Rarely

These usually go after verb to be and before the main verb

* Sammy is usually late for school *I often go to the cinema

*These go only at the beginning or end of the sentence

Every day -every week- every month etc *Every day we go to the shop to buy a cheese pie we go to the shop to buy a cheese pie every day

-There are some negative 'time guides' Never not often not always not always not usually *We don't often see you these days
