



It is an undeniable fact that wildlife is disappearing from the planet at a catastrophic rate. According to World Wildlife Fund (WWF), the number of birds, animals, marine and freshwater creatures have (1)dropped by almost one-third.

One reason for the 2 decline is man's ever increasing needs and greed that have resulted in habitat disappearance. For development purposes, man has felled trees to build dams, highways and towns and this



has forced the animals to retreat further and further into the receding forests. Moreover, rapid ③industrialization with its accompanying pollution and the use of pesticides and insecticides have made ④ survival difficult for a large number of animals and birds.
